



2016 Membership Options & Incentive Program

Family Golf Membership:

As a Family Golf Member of Vermont National Country Club you have use of all club amenities for your immediate family (spouse & children under age 23). The total first year commitment of \$8350* (entry fee, first year of dues plus dining minimum) can be paid in two equal installments, half with the receipt of application, second installment will be billed to your account on July 31st. After the first year the dues and fee structure (subject to change) will be as follows:

- Family Dues Annually: \$6740.25*
- Family Dining Minimum Yearly: \$750
- Bag Storage Yearly: \$175* per bag
- Locker Rental Yearly: \$125* per or \$195* for two lockers
(Two lockers is 1 in Men's and 1 on Women's)

Family Golf Incentive Program

If paid in full the new member will receive a \$500 credit off the first year commitment total.

Individual Golf Membership:

As an Individual Golf Member you have use of all club amenities and your spouse and children (children under age 23) have Social Membership privileges. The total first year commitment of \$6550* (entry fee, first year of dues plus dining minimum) can be paid in two equal installments, half with the receipt of application, second installment will be billed to your account on July 31st. After the first year the dues and fee structure (subject to change) will be as follows:

- Individual Dues Annually: \$4891.55*
- Individual Dining Minimum Yearly: \$550
- Bag Storage Yearly: \$175* per bag
- Locker Rental Yearly: \$125* per locker

Individual Golf Incentive Program

If paid in full the new member will receive a \$300 credit off the first year commitment total.

Executive Golf Membership – Ages 33 years and under:

As an Executive Golf Member you will have use of all club amenities and your spouse and children (under 23) have Social Membership privileges. The total first year commitment of \$3990* (Family) and \$3350* (Individual) (entry fee, first year of dues plus dining minimum) can be paid in two equal installments, half with the receipt of application;

second installment will be billed to your account on July 31st. After the first year the dues and fee structure (subject to change) will be as follows:

- Executive Family Dues Annually: \$3510.25*
- Executive Individual Dues Annually: \$2498.50*
- Individual Dining Minimum - \$275 / Family Dining Minimum - \$375
- Bag Storage Yearly: \$175* per bag
- Locker Rental Yearly: \$125* per locker \$195* for two lockers
(Two lockers is 1 in Men's and 1 on Women's)

Senior Membership (New Members Age 70 and up):

As a new Senior Golf Member (Age 70+) you will have use of all club amenities and your spouse and children (under 23) have Social Membership privileges. The total first year commitment of \$3990* (Family) and \$3350* (Individual) (entry fee, first year of dues plus dining minimum) can be paid in two equal installments, half with the receipt of application; second installment will be billed to your account on July 31st. After the first year the dues and fee structure (subject to change) will be as follows:

- Senior Family Dues Annually: \$3510.25*
- Senior Individual Dues Annually: \$2498.50*
- Annual Dining Minimum of \$275 for Individual - \$375 for Family
- Bag Storage Yearly: \$90* per bag
- Locker Rental Yearly: \$65* per locker \$110* for two lockers
(Two lockers is 1 in Men's and 1 on Women's)

Non-Resident Golf Membership (Must reside 75 miles from VNCC):

As a Non-Resident Member a one-time initiation fee of \$1950* will be due with your application.

- Non-Resident Yearly Dues: \$2400*
- No Dining Minimums
- Bag Storage Yearly: \$175* per bag (space available)
- Locker Rental Yearly: \$125* per locker \$195* for two lockers (space available)
(Two lockers is 1 in Men's and 1 on Women's)

Social Membership:

VNCC opened its front nine holes and driving range on July 17, 1998. The main Clubhouse, along with the Swim & Tennis facilities, opened during the late spring-early summer of 2000.
